While the Hunger Commission has not formally met since January, activity has continued in several areas.

- A successful seed drive was conducted with some 1500 packets distributed at no cost to senior residents of CHA housing. One hundred fifty-six dollars, over and above the cost of the flower and vegetable seeds, was collected and will be put towards a future project of the Commission.
- The broadly supported first Sunday monthly collection of non-perishable food for distribution by Loaves and Fishes is continuing. For May various members of the bean family are the featured item. Thanks to Nancy and Sam Leventry for staying on top of deliveries from CUMC to our local food pantry!
