

**Mission Committee Report to the Church Council
November 11, 2015**

Imagine No Malaria: CUMC has made a **\$30,000** pledged to Imagine No Malaria. This commitment is over a three-year period starting in 2014. In 2014, CUMC sent the Northern Illinois Conference **\$10,058.25**. In 2015 contributions are gathered through 2nd Mile Giving, the weekly Loose Coin collection and a silent auction for a quilt. To date 2015 Loose Coin has collected **\$ 2,909.41** and 2015 2nd Mile Giving another **\$2,086.59**. We have collected a total of \$15,099 or 50% of the pledged amount.

Honduras Missions Trip Planning: We have begun discussions with Woodridge United Methodist Church on the possibility of doing a joint Medical Mission to Honduras in 2016.

National Mission Trip: Dick Legg went on a mission trip to Detroit. He helped restore a basement that had been damaged by floods a year ago. The family can now use the space for bedrooms.

Statesville: To date three of the six members of CUMC have been certified to serve in this ministry. Once all have past the certification process they will meet with the chaplain at Statesville and determine a beginning date to start the program. It is likely to be in early 2016 at this point.

Feed My Starving Children: Planning has begun to participate in the Feed the Need event on Feb. 20-21 2016. Pies are currently on sale to raise funds for participation.

Refugee Support Planning: Four members of CUMC will attend the refugeeOne workshop at St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Park Ridge on Nov. 14.
