

Mission Committee Report to the Church Council
February 17, 2016

Imagine No Malaria: CUMC has made a **\$30,000** pledged to Imagine No Malaria. This commitment is over a three-year period starting in 2014. In 2014, CUMC sent the Northern Illinois Conference **\$10,058.25**. In 2015 contributions are gathered through 2nd Mile Giving, the weekly Loose Coin collection, a silent auction for a quilt and contributions made to the Christmas concert. The total 2015 contribution to INM was **\$7317.44** making a total contribution of **\$17,335.38** or **58%** of CUMC commitment. We will continue to collect loose coins in 2016 and look for additional ways to meet the commitment.

Honduras Missions Trip Planning: Woodridge United Methodist Church has committed to work with us in developing a joint Medical Mission to Honduras. The trip will likely be in 2017.

Daily Mission Trips: In conjunction with the United Methodist Men, Dick Legg has developed a relationship with Habitat for Humanity. There will be one day trips on April 9 and June 11.

Statesville: The chaplain at Statesville has once again changes. As a result we are unlikely to able to begin this Mission until the fall of 2016.

Feed My Starving Children: Approximately 60 CUMC members and friends will be packing meals for Feed the Need on Feb. 20-21 2016

Refugee Support Planning: A group of about 8-12 people are meeting on the first Sunday of the month and have decided to collect bimonthly donation for refugeeOne. The first collection ends on Sunday Feb. 21 and to date we have a large car full on donations. The second collection will be late March into April.
