- We ended the Heifer project with over \$4,300. We supplemented that to meet our goal of \$5,000 and maintained our tradition of receiving an "ark" certificate. In addition the Confirmation Class contributed over \$750 toward water projects through Heifer. It was a very successful drive.
- The lunch program generally slows down during the winter months and that has been true this
 year as well. We gave out a total of 25 lunches during January and February which is typical for
 the year. We have a good supply of items on hand and should see more demand as the weather
 warms.
- We have continued to supply Loaves and Fishes with generous donations of food. From
 November through January we sent over 500 lbs. and since then contributions have been
 generous. Thanks to Adam for supplying the cabinet in the hallway. As we all know, putting
 together IKEA furniture is a challenge in itself.
- The Seed Drive will end this week. We have paid for the display and then some. The final numbers are not in yet. We are the CHA's sole supplier of seeds now and will be going to their meeting on April 15 to present them to the housing managers.
- We will have a meeting in May to distribute several thousand dollars of our funds to UMCOR projects.
