

We have had an exciting spring in Trustees. Many of you have noticed that the offices have moved to the 3rd floor. Our Spring work day was a success with getting room 102 cleaned out for the asbestos abatement to take place. We were able to salvage the built in bookcases and cabinet that formerly held music. They have been moved other parts of the building, and are being used.

Trustees also made arrangements that plantings on the south lawn that would be impacted by the upcoming building project are moved to other parts of the property, or be taken by members for their own yards.

This spring also saw our beloved boiler sputter to a halt right at the end of heating season, but not before baking the sanctuary due to a thermostat issue. We will be replacing 3 leaking heat exchanger pipes in the boiler so it will be ready for the fall.

You may have noticed new cement sidewalks in front of the building. Cracked and uneven portions of the sidewalk that could be trip hazards were replaced. This is a city-wide program from the city of Naperville, and they split the cost with the building owner.

We will also be doing some maintenance work at the lansdale parsonage for Pastor Stephanie's arrival.

We are continuing to formulate and prioritize a list of projects at all 3 church properties. This will give us a better plan for budgeting and preventative maintenance.
