### Reports:

Bread for the World: Roger reported that Bread for the World would like us to call our Congress people and urge them to include in any budget bill they consider funding for effective poverty-focused assistance in programs in Central America that will address the root causes of poverty, hunger and violence that are driving parents to send their children to the United States. The U.S. capitol switchboard # is 800-825-3688. They will connect to with your congress person or senator.

CROP Walk: Jim reported that the CROP walk will be October 14th. They are hoping to get more of the youth to walk this year.

School Supplies: Kay reported that we have collected 88 scissors, 274 pads of paper, 137 rulers, 759 pencils, 197 erasers, 136 packs of 24 crayons, 56 pens and 8 protractors. These will be taken to the distribution center soon.

Lunches: Kay reported that we made available 125 lunches for the church office. We have a total of 12 lunches on hands as of September 8th.

Food Collections: In July 155 lbs and August 60 lbs of food was taken to Loaves and Fishes.
