### *Proverbs 8: 1-4, 22-31*

<sup>1</sup> Doesn't Wisdom call? Doesn't Understanding raise her voice? <sup>2</sup> On the hills along the road, at the crossroads, she takes her stand; <sup>3</sup> beside the city gates of the town, in the gates themselves, she cries out, <sup>4</sup> "Women and men, people everywhere, I'm calling out to you!
