Psalm 139

¹ YHWH, you've searched me, and you know me. ² You know if I am standing or sitting, you read my thoughts from far away. ³ Whether I walk or lie down, you are watching; you are intimate with all of my ways. ⁴ A word is not even on my tongue, YHWH, before you know what it is: ⁵ you hem me in, before and behind, shielding me with your hand. ⁶ Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, a height my mind cannot reach! ⁷ Where could I run from your spirit? Where could I flee from your presence? ⁸ If I go up to the heavens, you're there; if I make my bed in Death, you're already there. ⁹ I could fly away with wings made of dawn, or make my home on the far side of the sea, ¹⁰ but even there

All of my days were written in your book, all of them planned before even the first of them came to be. ¹⁷ How precious your thoughts are to me, O God! How impossible to number them! ¹⁸ I could no more count them than I could count the sand. But suppose I could? You would still be with me! ¹⁹ O God, if only you would destroy those degenerates! if only these reprobates would leave me alone! ²⁰ They talk blasphemously about you; your enemies treat you as if you were nothing. ²¹ Don't I hate those who hate you, YHWH? Don't I loathe those who defy you? ²² I hate them with a total hatred, and regard them as my own enemies! ²³ Examine me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts
